

TEST TICKET ASSIGNMENTS

Students must be eligible in order to take any math test.

Rationale: Students who have completed the independent practice assignments will most likely be able to pass the test.

Students who have not completed the independent practice assignments have not learned the material and will most likely fail the test.

Students must complete every test ticket assignment in order to be eligible for the test. **Not all assignments are test ticket assignments.** Test ticket assignments are independent practice assignments that the teacher knows must be completed in order for the students to have enough practice with problems/objectives that directly correlate to the course curriculum objectives. Students are told whether an assignment is a test ticket assignment when the assignment is given. A running list of test ticket assignments for a particular unit of study is posted in the classroom. Students **may use one** homework pass per unit of study in place of a test ticket assignment.

Eligible students will turn in all test tickets prior to starting the test. These assignments will become the basis for any tutoring that is required for students who do not perform well on the test. These students will be awarded one homework pass as a reward for choosing to do work on time.

Students who are not eligible for the test on the day of the test will work on the missing test ticket assignments while the eligible students take their tests. The teacher has the one-on-one or small group opportunity to assist students who are having trouble while the class is taking the test.

Students who are not eligible for the test on the day of the test will be assigned noon detention until the test ticket assignments have been completed and the test has been taken.

Students who are not eligible for the test on the day of the test will have three school days to come in before/after school or during lunch to complete their tests. After three days, the student will be given a zero.

Students who are not eligible for the test on the day of the test will **forfeit** their right to a retest.
